NARCOG Regional Transit Agency Proposed Program of Projects for Fiscal Year 2020

The North Central Alabama Regional Council of Governments (NARCOG) is applying to the Alabama Department of Transportation for an award to provide operational/planning/capital assistance under 49 U.S.C. Section 5307 of the Federal Transit Laws, as codified. The award will provide financial assistance for public transportation service for the residents of the Decatur, Alabama Urbanized Area during Fiscal Year 2020.

The estimated funds will be used as federal assistance for:

	Federal Share	Total
Operating	\$482,013	\$1,071,140
Capital and Preventive Maintenance	\$112,000	\$140,000
Bus Rolling Stock	\$88,000	\$110,000

The total program of projects estimated cost is \$1,321,140. Projects are funded at fifty/fifty (50/50) operating and eighty/twenty (80/20) capital and preventive maintenance. The Federal Transit Administration (FTA) share for the total program of projects is \$682,013. The remaining funds will be provided by the North Central Alabama Regional Council of Governments.
